The Board of Trustees of the JPGGADF is a distinguished group of individuals who brought together a wealth of experience, knowledge and a commitment to advancing education and social development. Among them are academicians, retired Vice Chancellor and visionaries with a deep appreciation for traditional culture.

Since its inception, JPGGADF has consistently pursued its mission of creating self-reliant communities through a participatory approach. This approach integrates the country's rich traditions and heritage with modern resources, providing opportunities for disadvantaged sections to develop and foster. The organization focuses on raising awareness, addressing social, economic and political issues that keep rural populations impoverished and deprived and emphasizing women's empowerment as well as slum development.

In addition to the school in Maharajganj, the organization expanded its educational activities to other districts of Uttar Pradesh in 2012. With support from the Government of India, the Government of Uttar Pradesh and Bihar, banks and volunteers from national and international universities, JPGGADF addresses various issues faced by resource-poor communities, including health, employment, agriculture, income generation and the environment, aiming to achieve the Millennium Development Goals (MDGs) at the village level.

JPGGADF has successfully implemented numerous Central and State projects, ensuring high-quality health facilities, safe drinking water, modern technical education, and self-employment opportunities. Through the State Water and Sanitation Mission, JPGGADF has conducted IEC/BCC activities in 25 districts and 12,450 Gram Panchayats, sensitizing approximately 458,790 people affected by JE/AES. The organization has provided sanitation facilities to 23,000 poor families and safe drinking water to 500,000 villagers. Furthermore, the number of individuals trained in community development has reached 384,143.

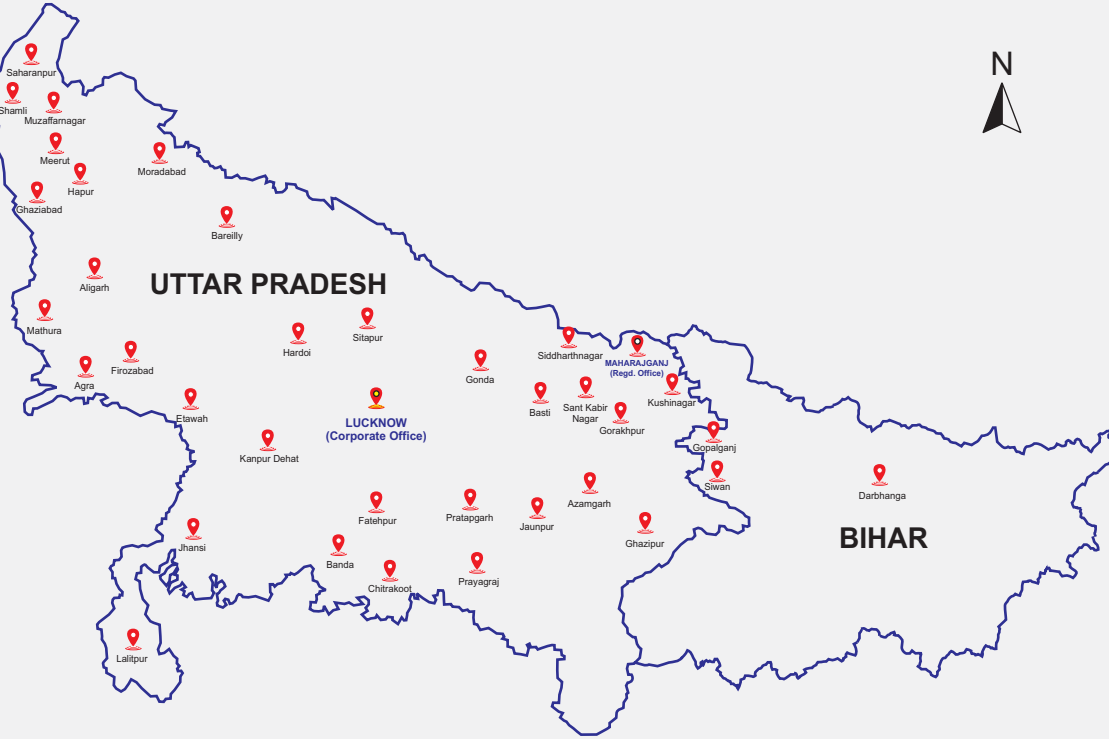
- To provide and help urban and rural poor in getting services such as health, nutrition, education, sanitation and housing.

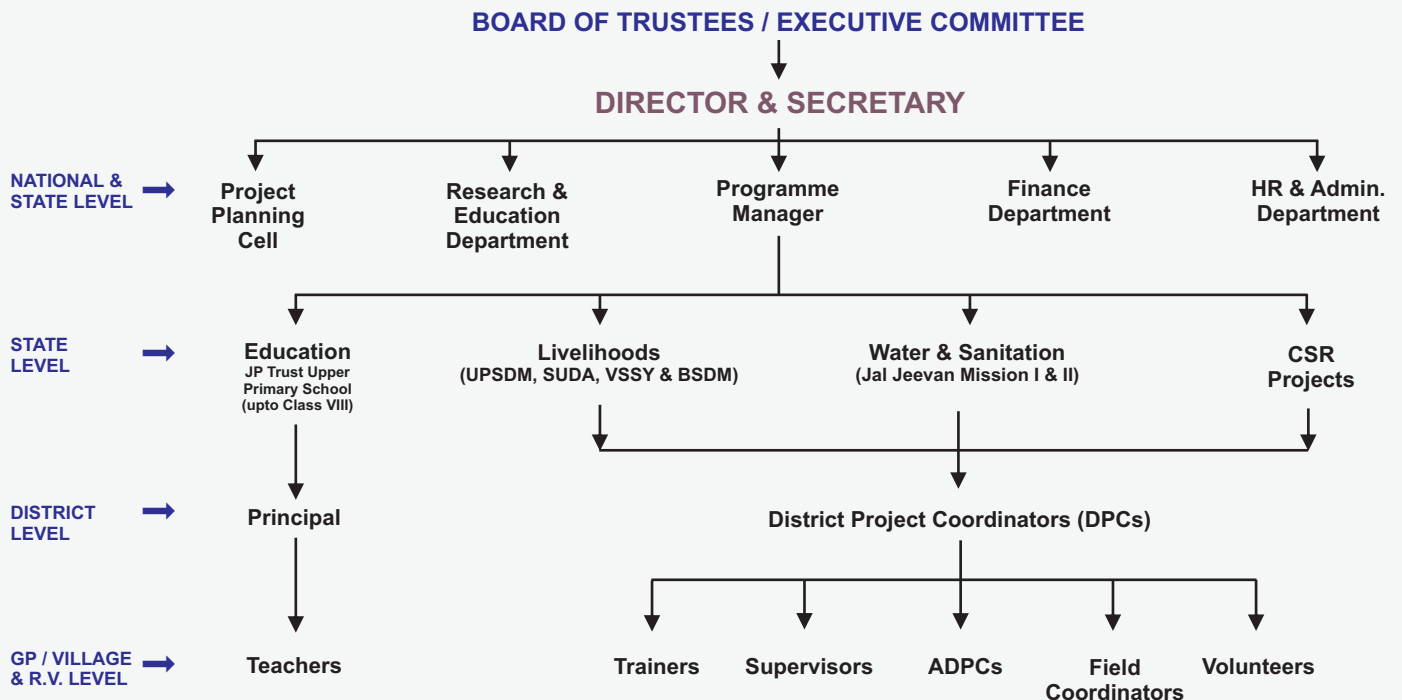

Assignments Undertaken

In 2010, JPGGADF embarked on a journey of targeted interventions to achieve its aims and objectives. The foundation began by establishing educational institutions funded by its own resources to provide quality education to children in rural areas. The activities organized by the JPGGADF team are described in three sections:

- **Institutions Established by JPGGADF:** A detailed account of the educational institutions set up to ensure access to quality education for rural children.
- **Projects Implemented in Partnership with the Government:** An overview of various projects carried out in collaboration with government agencies.
- **Welfare Activities Organized from Own Sources and Community Support:** A description of welfare initiatives funded by JPGGADF's resources and supported by the community.



Government Funded Programmes:

JPGGADF recognizes that partnering with the government facilitates the achievement of its organizational objectives more efficiently. Therefore, it consistently seeks to establish collaborations with the government to implement various development and welfare projects that share common goals and aim to be achieved in a participatory manner. During the reporting period, JPGGADF successfully implemented several government projects in partnership, aligning

these initiatives with the organization's goals. Additionally, JPGGADF organizes exposure visits for children to nearby parks and historical sites. These experiences broaden the children's horizons and enhance their understanding of the world.



Jal Jeevan Mission IEC Programme - U.P. State Water and Sanitation Mission under National Rural drinking Water Programme:

This project aims to highlight the impacts of the J P Global Governance And Development Foundation's initiative, "Safe Drinking Water and Sanitation Awareness Campaign," launched with the support of JAL JEEVAN MISSION Uttar Pradesh (UP) across various districts of Uttar Pradesh. The campaign's primary goal is to raise awareness about safe drinking water, BCC, health and hygiene conditions and water testing methods among villagers. J P Global Governance And Development Foundation has successfully conducted orientations, development and distribution of IEC materials, organisation of fairs (Melas), street plays, film & video shows, social mapping and water testing by visiting their respective villages. A field water testing kit was used to educate people about the risks of water contamination. The team from J P Global Governance And Development Foundation demonstrated various water testing methods



practically and suggested treatment methods to remove harmful chemical compositions from water while providing knowledge about hazardous diseases. Survey questionnaires were provided by JJM-UP, was used to gather responses from villagers. The current conditions of village water sources and sanitation infrastructure were assessed to achieve the campaign's objectives. Data was collected and analyzed to evaluate the campaign's effectiveness. The findings includes an impact analysis to highlight the campaign's positive and negative effects on the community. Additionally, suggestive indicators for the campaign's sustainability were captured.

Capacity Building and Training Programme under Jal Jeevan Mission:

The scope of work includes training of various stakeholders such as of Technical Support Manpower, Village Level Committees, Newly Elected/ Selected PRI's Members & Village Level Govt./Semi Govt. Personnel / Officials / social workers of all Districts of Uttar Pradesh etc. in phased manner, so as to achieve the objective as mentioned in this Programme 4 District in UP.

Phase-1

Training & awareness of 05 women of each revenue village about water quality through FTK kits.

Phase-2

Training – Capacity Building and Training of Technical Support Staff-02 Days Non-Residential Training, 200 Participants per batch at Block level - viz. Plumber, Pump Operator, Motor Mechanic, Fitter Electrician & Mason.



Phase-3

PRIs Elected/ Selected Member's - Pardhan, Ward Member's, Secretary, BDC, Lekhpal & Member`s etc. of District Board Representatives etc.

Phase -4

Govt. Officers & other Project Stakeholders at Village Level - Aganwadi, School Management Committee members, ASHA, ANM, Women's Group (SHG) etc.

Program for working children - (Scheme for welfare of working children in Need of Care and Protection):



This program offers invaluable opportunities, encompassing non-formal education and vocational training, with the aim of integrating working children into mainstream education and preventing ongoing or future exploitation. It fosters the holistic development of child workers residing in slums, combating addiction, or employed in shops, dhabas, mechanic shops and domestic settings. JGGADF manages this initiative in the Farrukhabad District of Uttar Pradesh, where 100 children receive formal education and vocational training. These children acquire a variety of skills, including candle making, agarbatti production, zari work, stitching, embroidery and envelope making. Moreover, the program imparts financial literacy, encouraging children to save money from their stipends. Consequently, at least 68% of the participants are successfully saving a portion of their earnings.

Skill training (EST&P) for UPSUDA, under the National Urban Livelihoods Mission:

As an empaneled organization (Skill Training Provider-STP) under the Uttar Pradesh State Urban Development Agency (UPSUDA), we conducted skill training programs for 180 students in the fields of Garment Making, Information and Communication Technology (ICT) and Beauty Culture & Hair Dressing in district of Maharajganj during the years 2015-2017. Each course was aligned with the standards set by the National Skill Development Council (NSDC). Our training centers were fully

equipped with state-of-the-art infrastructure and staffed by highly qualified instructors and teachers. The training programs in these diverse skill areas were successfully executed, culminating in assessments and certifications provided by the Regional Directorate of Apprenticeship Training (RDAT)-Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh. Following the successful completion of their training, more than 60% of the students were successfully placed in various jobs across the state, demonstrating the effectiveness and impact of our training initiatives.

Construction of Individual and Community Toilets and Solid Waste Management under the Swachh Bharat Mission:

Swachh Bharat Mission (Clean India Mission) The Swachh Bharat Mission aimed to achieve universal sanitation coverage and eliminate open defecation in rural areas. The project involved constructing 5,000 individual household latrines and 100 community toilets, conducting 50 awareness campaigns to promote sanitation practices and establishing waste segregation systems in 20 villages. These efforts led to all targeted villages achieving open defecation-free (ODF) status, with 90% of households regularly using the constructed toilets. The project significantly reduced waterborne diseases and improved village environments through better waste management and increased community awareness.

Skill Development Training (Residential) for RTD Project under BSDM in 3 districts of Bihar.

The J P Global Governance and Development Foundation (JPGGADF) is actively engaged as a Project Implementing Agency (PIA) for “Recruit – Train – Deploy” (RTD) project in Bihar, under the **Bihar Skill Development Mission**. Under this model, the organization undertakes end-to-end responsibility for mobilizing (recruiting) eligible rural youth, imparting structured skill training and ensuring their placement (deployment) in relevant industries. The project is being implemented through residential training centres in the districts of Gopalganj, Siwan and Darbhanga, with a focus on enhancing employability among economically weaker and marginalized sections of society.

Under this project, JPGGADF is delivering structured, residential training programmes aligned with industry standards and the National Skills Qualification Framework (NSQF). The organization is currently implementing training in two emerging and employment-oriented trades: Electric Vehicle Service Lead Technician and CCTV Video Footage Auditor. These trades have been carefully selected in response to the growing demand for skilled manpower in green mobility, surveillance systems and digital security sectors. The

residential training model adopted by JPGGADF ensures holistic development of candidates through technical training, soft skills, digital literacy, and continuous mentoring, along with assured placement support as per BSDM norms.

In terms of scale and targets, JPGGADF has set a clear and progressive training roadmap. For the financial year 2025-26, the organization aims to train **400 candidates in each trade**, namely Electric Vehicle Service Lead Technician and CCTV Video Footage Auditor, across its centres in the identified districts. This target is further planned to be expanded to **575 candidates per trade** in the financial year 2026-27, reflecting both the organization's operational capacity and the increasing demand for skilled professionals in these sectors. Cumulatively, this represents a significant contribution towards skill development and employment generation in Bihar under the BSDM framework.

Through these initiatives, JPGGADF is positioning itself as a forward-looking training partner that not only aligns with national skilling priorities but also addresses future industry needs. By focusing on high-demand and technology-driven job roles,

the organization is creating sustainable livelihood opportunities for rural youth while supporting Bihar's transition towards a skilled and industry-ready workforce.

Free Tobacco - Awareness Initiative

JP Global Governance and Development Foundation (JPGGADF) implemented the “Free Tobacco” Awareness Initiative in various locations of district Maharajganj (U.P.) with the objective of promoting a tobacco-free society and reducing the health and social risks associated with tobacco consumption. The initiative was designed to sensitize communities, especially youth and vulnerable groups, about the harmful effects of tobacco use and to encourage behavioral change towards healthier lifestyles.

The program included a series of awareness activities such as community meetings, school-based sessions and interactive discussions. These activities highlighted the adverse health impacts of tobacco consumption, including its link to serious illnesses such as cancer, respiratory diseases and heart conditions. Participants were also informed about the economic burden of tobacco addiction on families and society.

Special focus was given to engaging youth and students as change agents by encouraging them to take a pledge against tobacco use and to spread awareness within their families and peer groups. Informational materials such as pamphlets and posters were distributed to reinforce key messages and ensure wider outreach.

Where possible, the initiative also facilitated basic counseling and guidance for individuals willing to quit tobacco, connecting them with

appropriate support systems and health services. The program emphasized community participation and collective responsibility in creating a tobacco-free environment. The program had a positive impact with an outreach of more than 5000 people in the community.

Through this initiative, JPGGADF contributed to improving public health awareness, promoting preventive healthcare and fostering a culture of responsible and informed decision-making within the community.

Plantation Drive

JP Global Governance and Development Foundation (JPGGADF) organized a Plantation Drive in several location of district Maharajganj in the July'2025 as part of its commitment to environmental sustainability, climate action and community engagement. The initiative aimed to increase green cover, promote ecological balance and create awareness among communities about the importance of tree plantation and environmental conservation.

The drive was conducted with active participation from local residents, students, volunteers and community stakeholders. Around 10,000 saplings were distributed in the schools and in the community with a variety of saplings, including fruit-bearing, medicinal, ornamental and shade-giving trees, were planted across selected locations such as

school premises, community lands, roadside areas and other public spaces.

Prior to the plantation activity, awareness sessions were conducted to educate participants on the importance of trees in maintaining ecological balance, improving air quality, conserving biodiversity and mitigating the effects of climate change. Demonstrations were also provided on proper plantation techniques, soil preparation, watering methods and post-plantation care to ensure higher survival rates of saplings.



Special emphasis was placed on community ownership and sustainability, encouraging local residents and institutions to take responsibility for nurturing and protecting the planted saplings. In some cases, school students and community groups were assigned specific plants to monitor their growth, thereby fostering a sense of accountability and environmental stewardship.

The Plantation Drive not only contributed to enhancing the green cover but also instilled environmental awareness and responsibility among participants, aligning with JPGGADF's broader mission of sustainable and inclusive development.

Rozgar Mela (Employment Fair)

JPGGADF organized a Rozgar Mela (Employment Fair) in as a strategic intervention

to address unemployment and enhance livelihood opportunities for youth and marginalized sections of society. The event served as a dynamic platform that brought together job seekers, employers, industry representatives and skill development agencies under one roof.

The Rozgar Mela witnessed enthusiastic participation from a large number of candidates, including fresh graduates, school dropouts and unemployed youth. Multiple companies

across sectors such as retail, healthcare, manufacturing, logistics and services participated in the fair, offering on-the-spot interviews, job placements and apprenticeship opportunities. Skill training institutions and government-supported programs also set up information kiosks to guide participants about various vocational courses and certification programs aligned with market demand.

In addition to job placements, the event included structured career counseling sessions, soft skills workshops, and orientation programs on resume writing, interview techniques, and workplace readiness. Special efforts were made to ensure inclusion of women, differently-abled individuals, and economically weaker sections by providing them with equal access to opportunities.

The Rozgar Mela significantly contributed to bridging the gap between demand and supply in the job market and empowered participants with the knowledge, confidence, and opportunities required for sustainable employment and self-reliance.

Piyau (Free Drinking Water Facility)

As part of its humanitarian and community welfare initiatives, JPGGADF established Piyau (Free Drinking Water Facilities) in several districts of U.P. to provide safe and accessible drinking water to the public, particularly during the peak summer season. Recognizing the hardships faced by daily commuters, laborers, and underprivileged sections during extreme heat conditions, the organization identified strategic high-footfall locations such as marketplaces, bus stands, hospitals, and roadside areas for setting up these facilities.



Each Piyau was equipped with clean water storage systems, proper dispensing arrangements, and measures to maintain hygiene and sanitation. Volunteers and local community members were actively engaged in the regular maintenance, refilling and monitoring of the facilities to ensure uninterrupted service. Awareness messages promoting water conservation and hygiene practices were also displayed at these sites.

In some locations, the initiative was further strengthened by community participation, where local stakeholders contributed to the upkeep and sustainability of the Piyau. The facility not only provided immediate relief from heat but also reflected the organization's compassionate approach toward addressing basic human needs.

This initiative stands as a testament to JPGGADF's dedication to public service and its commitment to improving the quality of life for vulnerable populations.

Cultural Programs in Schools

JPGGADF organized a series of Cultural Programs in Schools with the aim of enhancing creativity, cultural awareness and holistic development among students. 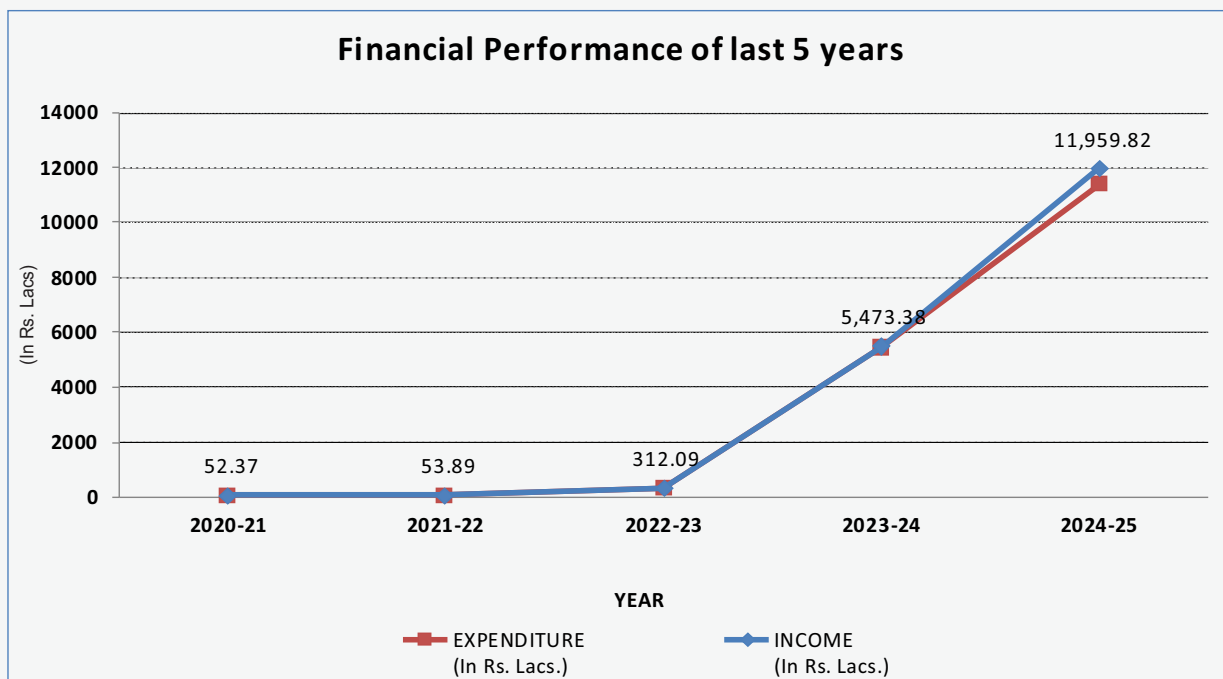
